- Recognize and Diagnose Usual (HPV-associated) and less common (non-HPV associated) endocervical adenocarcinomas in biopsy/cone specimens.
- Recognize when to utilize immunohistochemical and molecular studies to identify uterine epithelial tumors with potentially targetable therapy.
- Identify and define massive transfusion and key principles of implementing a whole blood resuscitation MTP.
- Identify and correctly grade prostate cancer on a biopsy and understand and then apply grade group classifications.

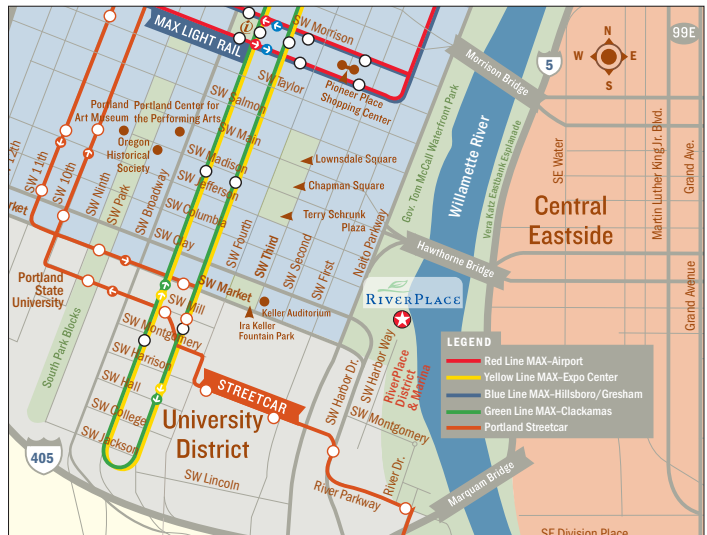
