## MEETING OBJECTIVES:

- Identify Fibroepithelial Lesions of the Breast.
- Recognize Spindle Cell lesions of the Breast.
- Evaluate In situ Carcinomas of the Breast.
- Evaluate Breast Specimens after Neoadjuvant Systemic Therapy.
- Identify the basics of mammography and ultrasound of the breast and understand their role in screening and diagnosis.
- Identify and assess new entities using common pathology tools (morphology, immunohistochemistry and genetics).
- Recognize pathologic features that are signs of malignancy or infection.
- Identify subtle clues aiding in diagnosis of “non-specific” lesions.
- Use eponymous names in dermatology/dermatopathology with an understanding of their historical significance.
- Identify the morphologic criteria of benign and malignant processes in all types of breast specimens.
- Relate to the clinician’s rationale for taking a biopsy and evaluate diagnostic categories for the clinically brown skin lesion.
- Determine and re-evaluate the validity of measuring distance to margins for skin tumors and describe the function of the “tip” in creation of an elliptical skin excision.
